### **Domestic Video Surveillance (CCTV) Systems and Data Protection**



### **PSA Prosecution for unlicensed Door Security**

On the 27 November 2024, the Private Security Authority (PSA) prosecuted H&H Security Limited of Turra, Ballickmoyler, Co. Laois for breaches of the Private Security Services Acts. The Judge awarded costs of €5,935.44 against the company. The prosecution arose from an investigation by the PSA into the provision of door supervisor services in Enniscorthy, Co Wexford during 2022.

## Helping Us Make A Decision On Your Application

Every year, the PSA makes thousands of decisions on whether to grant or refuse a licence. Most applicants are granted a licence but if your application is being considered for refusal we will notify you in advance and provide you with an opportunity to make representations as to why we should not refuse your application.

When responding to such a notification the following are some of the things which might support your application:

- Evidence of rehabilitation.
- References - Independent references will bear a greater influence over references from family members or friends. References must clearly describe how they know you and the time period over which they have known you. They must also confirm that they know about the reason(s) why your application is being considered for refusal by referring to the specifics and are still prepared to provide the reference.

## Reporting A Crime

One of our objectives is to reduce criminality and misconduct in the security industry. We work closely with An Garda Síochána, Revenue Commissioners and other public bodies to tackle illegal activity.
